POSITION: Crisis Nursery Supervisor

LOCATION: South Crisis Nursery (S. Land Park Dr.)

OVERVIEW

The Crisis Nursery Supervisor (CNS) has primary responsibility for supervising the daily operation of the Nursery. The CNS oversees the staffing, health, safety and care of children in accordance with program licenses and agency policies and systems. In the absence of the Program Manager, the CNS accepts administrative responsibility for the program. The CNS ensures age appropriate curriculum is utilized to meet the needs of the children. This position requires on-call shift responsibilities and the ability to work a flexible schedule including days, evenings, nights, weekends and holidays.

QUALIFICATIONS:

High school graduation or GED; completion, with passing grades, of 15 semester or equivalent quarter units at an accredited or approved college or university; and at least four years of teaching experience in a licensed child care center or comparable group child care program.

- Three of the 15 units shall be in Administration or Staff Relations.
- Three ECE units in Infant Care.
- Twelve of the 15 units required shall include courses that cover the general areas of Child Growth and Development, or Human Growth and Development; Child, Family and Community, or Child and Family; and Program/Curriculum.

OR

An Associate of Arts degree from an accredited or approved college or university with a major or emphasis in Early Childhood Education or Child Development; and at least two years of teaching experience in a licensed child care center or comparable group child care program.

- Three semester or equivalent quarter units shall be in Administration or Staff Relations.
- Three ECE units in Infant Care.

OR

A Bachelor's degree from an accredited or approved college or university with a major or emphasis in Early Childhood Education or Child Development and at least one year of teaching experience in a licensed child care center or comparable group child care program.

- Three semester or equivalent quarter units shall be in Administration or Staff Relations.
- Three ECE units in Infant Care.

OR

A Child Development site Supervisor Permit or a Child Development Program Director Permit issued by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
